

Fees for Clinic Sliding Fee Program – Starting on January 1, 2020

To find your fee:

1. Find the row that has the number of people living in your household.
2. Starting on the left, go across that row. Find the first column with an amount that is **more** than what you make in a year.
3. Go down that column to find your fee. The top of the column has your plan name.

For example: If you have 4 people living in your household and make \$26,000 a year your new copay would be \$20 and you would be on Plan B.

Understanding Your Visit Fee

Visit Fee Pays For:

- All medications provided at the clinic
- Flu shots
- Baby and Child Immunizations (Vaccines)
- Injectable medications
Examples: a shot to numb you before stitches, Depo-Provera (birth control), or antibiotics
- Diagnostic testing done in the Doctors Care Clinic
Examples: EKGs, spirometry, visual acuity (eyesight test), and audiometry (hearing tests)
- All screenings
Examples: developmental and behavioral health screenings)
- All labs done by Doctors Care
Examples: urinalysis, urine pregnancy test, rapid strep)
This does not include labs collected at Doctors Care and sent to an outside laboratory. Your provider will talk to you about labs they would like you to complete and the cost at your visit.

Visit Fee Does NOT Pay For:

- Any labs or pathology done by an outside lab
- Any diagnostic imaging done by an outside provider
- Medications given out at a pharmacy
- Nebulizer machines
- Adult immunizations (vaccines) other than flu shots

Extra Charges:

- Casting and custom splints - \$50
- In stock splints and braces - \$50
- Long acting reversible contraception (IUD Implants) - \$800-\$900
- Medical supplies or equipment not in stock at Doctors Care
