**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Because of the high volume of claims, the state is asking that you help us help you and our greater community.

Please File a claim on the time listed for your LAST name

- Last name begins with the letter A - M, file a claim on Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday, or after 12 noon on Saturday.
- Last name begins with the letter N - Z, file a claim on Monday, Wednesday, Friday or before 12 noon on Saturday.

**Housing Information:** As of Gov. Polis’ press conference on 3/20/2020:

- Landlords are asked not to charge late fees for rent until April 30
- Polis has asked law enforcement to not use resources to respond to foreclosures or evictions
- Utility companies have been asked not to shut off service for people who cannot pay
